The MBA Labour & Employment Section organized three events during the 2017-2018 year.

On October 10, 2017, the Section co-hosted a CPD session with the Young Lawyers entitled "Preparing for and Conducting Labour Arbitrations". The session featured a panel including The Honourable Martin Freedman, Q.C., Grant Mitchell, Q.C., and Susan Dawes of Myers LLP. This was a very informative session led by an experienced arbitrator and senior counsel who shared their advice and experiences on preparing for and conducting a successful labour arbitration.

On November 22, 2017, the Section hosted its 3rd Annual Wine and Cheese Reception, which provided Section members with the opportunity to connect in an informal setting with fellow colleagues who practice in the areas of labour and employment law
